FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Q: Is this scholarship open to students of all fields of study?

A: Students of all fields of study are welcome to apply. However, applicants must be prepared to serve employment bond in Public Bank Group of Companies upon completion of study.

Q: Can I apply if I'm doing a twinning programme or credit transfer (e.g., UK/Australia transfer programmes)?

A: This scholarship is only eligible to applicants who fully pursue their undergraduate programmes at any recognised public/private university in Malaysia.

Q: Can I apply if I am currently receiving other scholarship/ study loan/ grant?

A: Applicants must not be in receipt of any financial aid from or bonded by any other organisation.

Q: What documents do I need to submit?

A: Please refer to the list of required documents on the webpage by clicking 'Required Documents'. Kindly ensure that all the required documents are ready to be uploaded prior to filling up the Online Submission Form.

Q: Can I upload the provisional results for my pre-university qualification pending the official certificate?

A: Yes. However, applicants must provide us the official copy upon receiving it from the educational institution thereafter.

Q: Can I apply if I have yet to receive my degree offer letter?

A: Yes, applicants may still apply prior to receiving offer letter from their university at the time of application. However, they must provide the university offer letter when they are shortlisted for further assessments.

Q: What is a Surety and who can be my Surety?

A: A Surety is someone agrees to be legally and financially responsible if the scholarship recipient fails to fulfill the terms and conditions of the Scholarship Agreement. The Surety must be a Malaysian who is above 21 years old as well as gainfully employed. It can be the applicant's parents, legal guardians or relatives provided they meet the requirements.

Q: What does the selection process involve?

A: Shortlisted applicants will be invited for interview and assessments.

Q: How will I know if my application is successful?

A: Successful applicants will be notified via phone or email for the next steps.

Q: Can I still submit my application after the deadline?

A: Any applications submitted after the stipulated deadline will not be considered.

Q: What are the requirements to fulfill during the period of scholarship?

A: Scholarship recipients are expected to satisfy all course works, examination and attendance requirements as well as maintaining a minimum CGPA of 3.30 every semester for continuation of the scholarship.

Q: What happens if I change courses or universities after receiving the scholarship?

A: Applicants are strongly discouraged to change their course of study or university after awarded the scholarship.

Q: Can I pursue postgraduate studies after graduation before serving the bond?

A: No, scholarship recipients are expected to fulfill the employment bond immediately upon completion of their undergraduate programme.
